HOW TO CREATE A FACEBOOK FUNDRAISER

Follow these simple steps to create your STEPtember Facebook Fundraiser.


<u>IMPORTANT</u>: You MUST create your Facebook Fundraiser through your STEPtember dashboard to make sure all donations appear on your STEPtember fundraising page.

STEP 1: Log in to your STEPtember dashboard: www.steptember.us/login.


STEP 2: Click on the 'create a Facebook Fundraiser' button under your name.



STEP 3: A new window will open to connect to your Facebook account. Verify your account and click 'Continue.'




STEP 4: Next, give permission to your STEPtember page to create a Facebook Fundraiser. Click 'OK.'



STEP 5: Congratulations! You've created your Facebook Fundraiser and it's linked to your STEPtember fundraising page!

STEP 6: To view your Facebook Fundraiser, open your STEPtember dashboard from a desktop computer and click 'view Facebook Fundraiser.'

TIPS TO MAXIMIZE YOUR FACEBOOK FUNDRAISER IMPACT

TIP 1: **ADD A COVER PHOTO** to your Facebook Fundraiser. We've created one for you that you can download here.

TIP 2: INVITE your followers on Facebook to support you. Just click the invite buttons (see above) and let Facebook do the rest.

TIP 3: **UPDATE & SHARE** your Facebook Fundraisers regularly. Whenever you're on Facebook, write a post, tell all your followers how many steps you've taken or how you've moved so far, and share your Facebook Fundraiser on your timeline.
